

Fire District #1 of Leavenworth County is currently seeking highly motivated, professional, and service oriented people for the position of Firefighter. Fire District #1 serves a community of approximately 20,000 + citizens within 78 square miles, from two fire stations serving the City of Lansing, High Prairie Township and Delaware Township. Fire District #1 is a combination fire service organization consisting of ten full time, six part-time and 20 volunteer suppression personnel. The communities served by Fire District #1 have experienced consistent growth, are considered a highly desirable area to live with one of the best school districts in the State of Kansas.

Minimum qualifications to be considered:

- High school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency.
- Must be 19 years of age by the first day of employment.
- Must possess a valid driver's license and maintain an insurable driving record.
- Kansas Emergency Medical Technician certification or National Registry Emergency Medical Technician with the ability to gain Kansas certification by the first day of employment. Certification must be maintained as a job requirement.
- Kansas Firefighter I & II certification or equivalent (IFSAC or Pro Board). Including Haz-Mat certification for the First Responder at the operational level.
- Driver/Operator certification is preferred or have the ability to obtain within one-year of employment.
- Must have and maintain a current certification in Health Care Provider CPR/AED.
- NIMS ICS certification to the ICS 200 level along with IS 700 and 800.
- Successful completion of the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) within 1 year of application submission.
- Fire Service Entrance Exam (FSEE) with a minimum score of 70%.

Process:

- The application packet must be submitted before the close of business on Friday August 14th, 2020. The application packet must include the following in order to be considered for this full-time position:
  1. A completed Fire District #1 application. The application is available on the District's website ( [http://lvcofiredistrict1.com/files/Form-21-Fire\\_Dept\\_App.pdf](http://lvcofiredistrict1.com/files/Form-21-Fire_Dept_App.pdf) ). An application can also be obtained at Station One (111 E. Kansas, Lansing, Kansas 66043) or an application can be mailed to you.
  2. A copy of your Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certification.
  3. A copy of your Fire Service Entrance Exam (FSEE).
  4. A copy of your current EMT certification and BLS provider CPR/AED.
  5. A copy of your NIMS ICS certificates.
  6. A current resume and must include education and credentials and ten years of employment history.
  7. A cover letter explaining why you are seeking employment as a full-time firefighter with Fire District #1 of Leavenworth County.
  8. Five professional references including contact information.

- Successful candidates who receive a conditional job offer will be required to successfully pass a medical exam, drug screening, and pre-employment background screening.

Salary and Benefits:

- Probationary Firefighter (one-year): \$39,117 to \$49,965 DOQ.
- After successful completion of probation: \$41,888 to \$54,961.
- Health and dental insurance. Employee pays 15% of the plan.
- Vision insurance, 100% paid for by the employee.
- State sponsored defined pension plan (KP&F).
- Fire District sponsored gym membership.
- Continued training opportunities.
- Participation in special teams after successfully completing the one-year probationary period.
